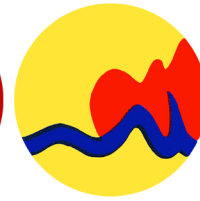


GRSCI - Perugia Sister Cities Scholarship 2026



UNISTRA Entrance

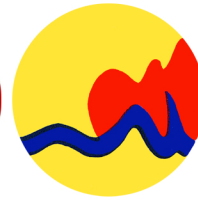

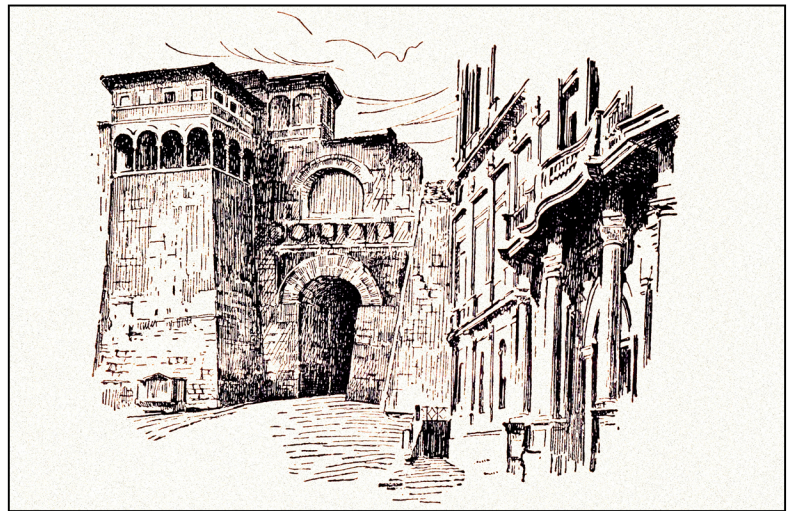

2. Independence, self-sufficiency, adaptability, and previous travel experience, or can establish examples of independent living.
3. Past efforts to learn a foreign language.

- a. Application Form
- b. Resume
- c. Cover letter addressing the above criteria and the following questions in 1000 words or less.
 1. What inspires you to study abroad in Italy and study the Italian language?
 2. How will you contribute to the sister city mission and relationships while you are in Perugia and when you return to Grand Rapids?
 3. How will this experience impact your future plans or goals?
- d. Two letters of recommendation

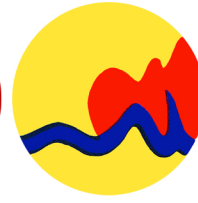

GRSCI - Perugia Sister Cities Scholarship 2026 - Application



This language scholarship includes:

1. A four-week Italian language course, any level, at the University for Foreigners (UNISTRA) in Perugia, Italy. Class placement will be determined on site based on skill level.
2. A modest living stipend offered by UNISTRA during the scholarship period, available with documented class attendance.
3. A cash award from the GRSCI Perugia Committee covering a significant portion of the travel expenses from Grand Rapids to Perugia. Amount varies and is subject to annual funding review.

Application Requirements:

1. Kent County resident or a student attending a Grand Rapids area college or university.
2. Non-students are asked to join the GRSCI Perugia Committee, attend monthly meetings for at least one year from the date of the award, participate in committee activities, and encourage membership with others.
3. Within 60 days of returning from Perugia, recipients are required to present an in-person report of their experiences to the Perugia Committee, including photographs.
4. Submit the following:
 - a. Completed Application
 - b. Resume with cover letter
 - c. Two letters of recommendation

Classes start at the beginning of each month and last four weeks. The recipient(s) of a 2026 scholarship can select any month remaining in the year once notified of selection, provided ample time to enroll is available.
